A booking form for hotel rooms can be found on the Keeshond Club website. Please take careful note of the booking deadline to ensure that you benefit from the reduced room rate. If you are staying at the hotel check-in is from 3.00 pm. The hotel will charge £15 per room, per night for up to 2 dogs in a room.

Dogs are only allowed in the Windmill and Pickford Suites and the outside standard hotel rooms. Please enter these suites via the signposted route – not through the Hotel Reception area.

It is possible to purchase a full breakfast in the Hotel dining room. Evening meals are available in the Cellars Bar and the Loft18 restaurant.

Please note that no cash transactions can be accepted in the hotel. This applies to Reception and food and beverage facilities.

## Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> May: Evening Reception

There will be a complimentary Evening Reception with finger buffet from 6 pm to 7.30 pm in the Pickford Suite. Numbers are required for catering purposes.

## Saturday, 3<sup>rd</sup> May: Centenary Championship Show and Gala Dinner

Judging of the Centenary Championship Show will start at 9.30 am in the Windmill Suite. The show will open at 8.30 am. The show will close half an hour after the completion of judging.

Sandwiches and chips will be available to purchase in the Windmill Suite at lunchtime at a cost of £7.00 and £3.00 respectively. These must be ordered on the food booking form below. The sandwich contents will be at the chef's discretion so the hotel cannot be specific before the day, so please indicate the number of servings required and whether you would like a vegetarian choice. Food allergies should be indicated on the form. Tea and coffee will be available for the duration of the championship show to purchase at a cost of £1.25 per mug. The downstairs bar will be open for the purchase of food at lunchtime but no dogs will be allowed in the bar and please be aware of time constraints, if ordering food in the bar, if you need to be back at ringside in the afternoon.

Dogs are not to be left in the Windmill or Pickford Suites after the close of the show.

Dinner will be at 7.30 pm for 8.00 pm until 9.45 pm. A bottle of red wine and a bottle of white wine have been donated for each dinner table. Please make your food choices on the attached form for catering purposes by 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

## Sunday, 4th May: Centenary Dog of the Year competition

The Dog of the Year (DOTY) competition criteria will be published in due course. The competition will start at 10.00 am in the Windmill Suite and will open for exhibitors at 9.00 am. The competition will close half an hour after the completion of judging.

The cost will be £5 per dog entered plus £25 to include a two-course hot and cold buffet lunch. If you require lunch, whether you are a competitor or a spectator, please order lunch on the attached food booking form. Complimentary teas and coffees will be available on arrival and after lunch.
